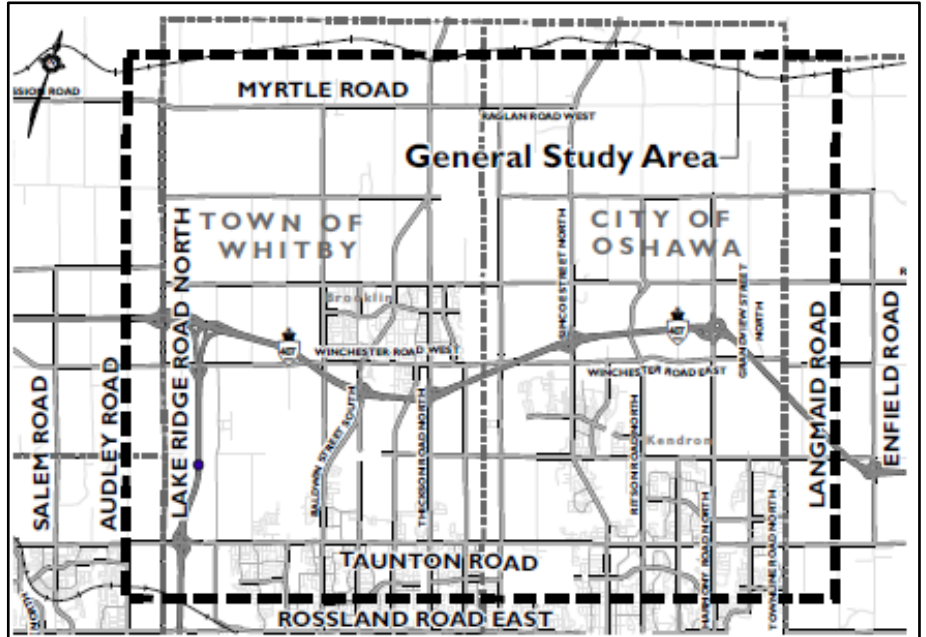

The Regional Municipality of Durham (Region) is undertaking a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) study to identify the preferred long-term water storage and pumping solution that meets the servicing requirements for the existing population and projected growth in the Zone 4 and Zone 5 water pressure districts in Whitby and Oshawa to 2031 and beyond.

The study is being conducted in accordance with the requirements for Schedule 'B' projects under the Municipal Class EA process as set out by the Municipal Engineers' Association.
