Watermain Construction – Road Closure

The Regional Municipality of Durham will be completing watermain construction on Thorah Concession Road 5 from Cedar Beach Road to the Lake Simcoe Water Pollution Control Plant entrance. The work will include installation of a 300 millimetre diameter PVC watermain and includes micro-tunnelling operations under the Canadian National Railway tracks.

Construction Schedule

The Region's contractor **North Rock Group** will be re-mobilizing the week of April 3, 2023 and anticipates completing the work by mid-July 2023. Unfavorable weather conditions may influence the work schedule.

Lane Restrictions and Road Closure

Thorah Concession Road 5 will be closed to through traffic from Cedar Beach Road to Murray Street from April 3 to June 30, 2023. Local residences and businesses on Concession Road 5 and Moorlands Drive within the limits of the closure will be provided access. A signed detour route will be in place.

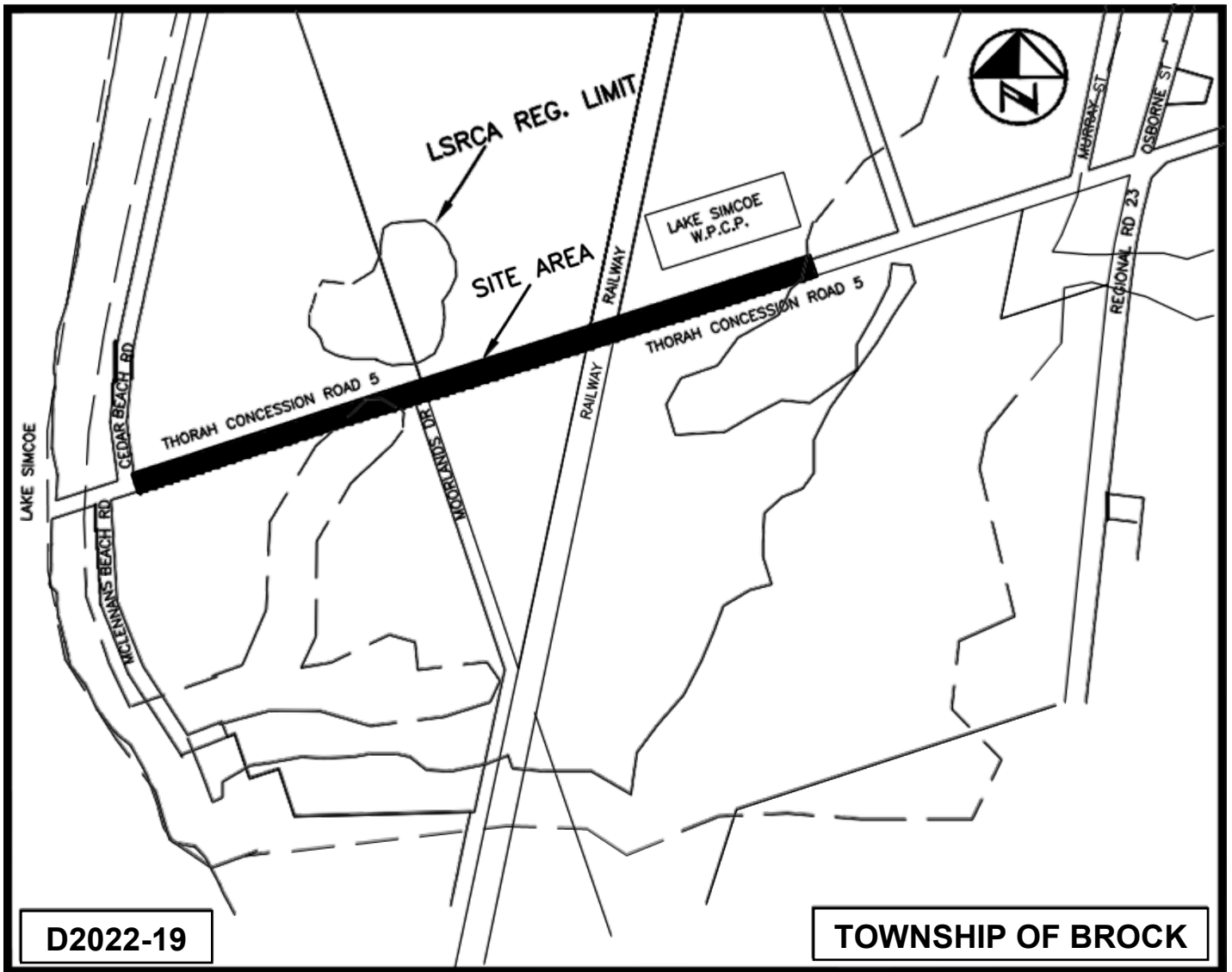
