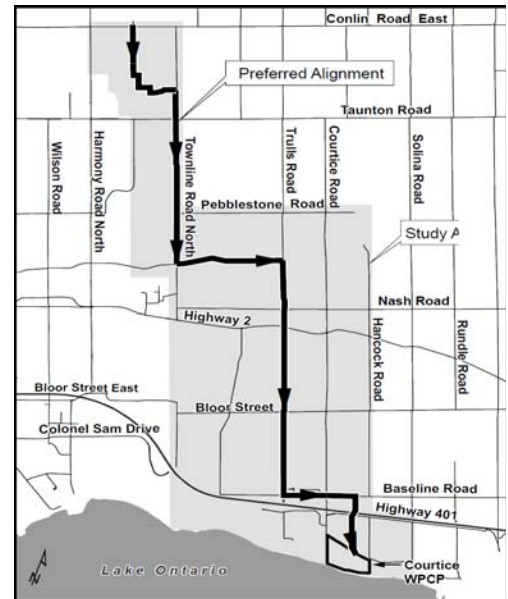

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Regional Municipality of Durham has completed a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to identify the preferred route for the Courtice Trunk Sanitary Sewer in the communities of Oshawa and Courtice. In accordance with the Region's wastewater servicing strategy, the sanitary sewer is planned to convey sanitary flows from north Whitby (Brooklin), north Oshawa, and Courtice to the Courtice Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP). The preferred alternative is illustrated on the adjacent figure.

The Class EA Study has been conducted in accordance with Schedule "B" of the Municipal Class EA process. The Project File Report, documenting Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class EA process for this Study, has been prepared and is available for a 30 day public review and comment period from March 30, 2011 to May 6, 2011 during regular business hours at the following locations:

Under the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and the Environmental Assessment Act, unless otherwise stated in the submission, any personal information included in a submission will become part of the public record files for this matter and will be released, if requested, to any person.
