



Harmony Road North (Regional Road 33) in the City of Oshawa

Road Widening and Watermain

Works Department

Public Notice #1

The Regional Municipality of Durham has awarded the contract for Harmony Road North from Coldstream Drive to Conlin Road East, in the City of Oshawa. Construction includes road widening, curb and gutter work, road paving, storm sewer replacement and watermain work and the installation of new traffic control signals, lighting, sidewalk and multi-use path.

Construction Schedule

The Region's contractor, **Hard-Co Construction Ltd.**, will begin mobilizing the week of October 5. Work is expected to be completed by the end of September 2021. Unfavourable weather conditions may influence the work schedule.

Lane Restrictions & Road Closures

Throughout construction the roadways will remain open to one lane of traffic in each direction, and periodic lane restrictions may occur. Pedestrians will have access to the existing sidewalk on one side of the road at all times. Durham Region Transit routes and bus stops will also be maintained within the limits of construction.

Road closures of local connecting streets will occur to help safely complete work in the intersections, and residents will receive advance notice prior to the closures.

Local residents should expect minor traffic delays and are asked to exercise additional caution for the safety of the construction workers. Access to residential driveways will be maintained whenever possible. Notification will be given to residents if vehicles need to be moved out of the driveway.

Businesses

Businesses will remain open for the duration of construction. The Region recognizes there may be potential impacts during the work. 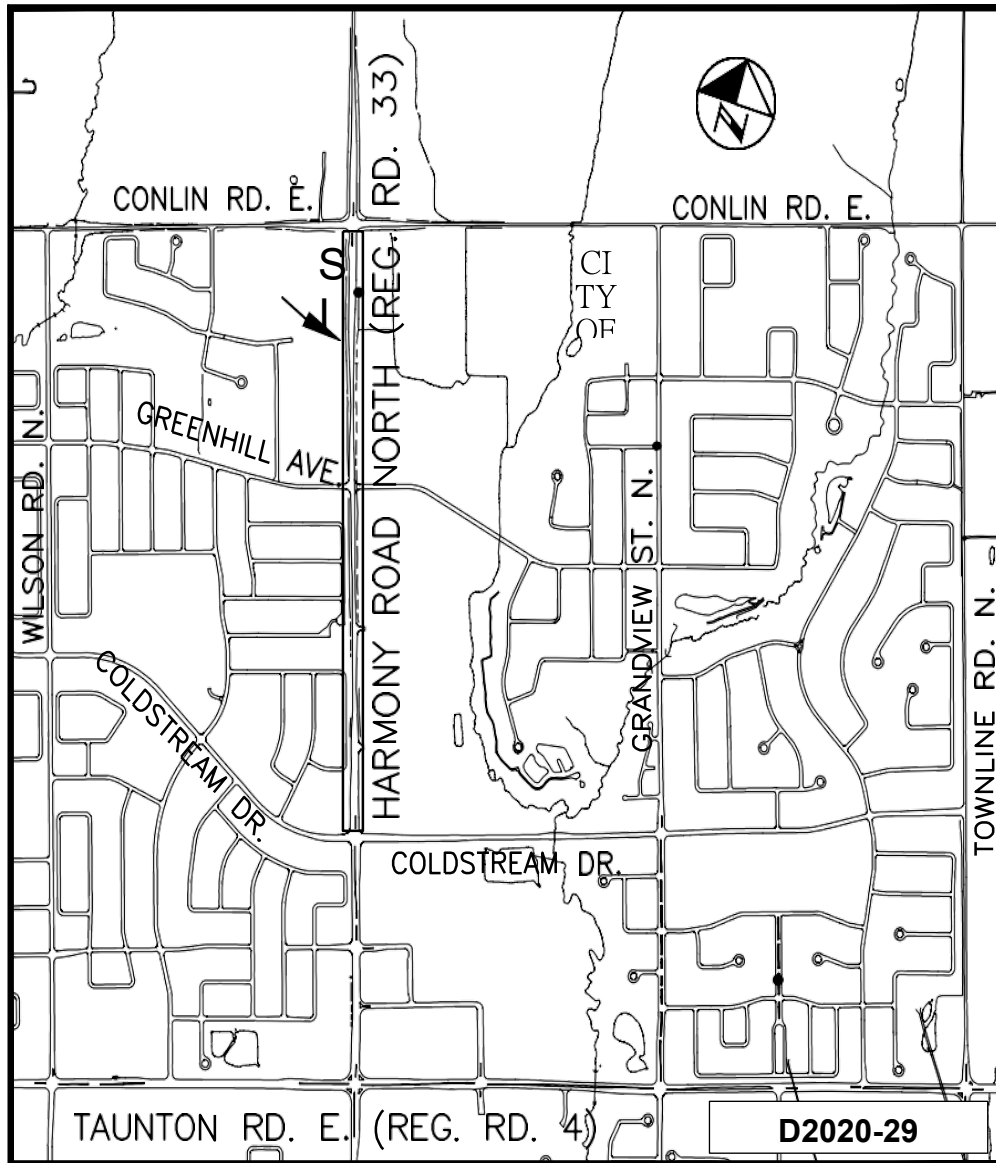
